

MUSICAL THEATRE PITCH POINT

NYFA, School of Musical Theatre provides professional training with top-tier Broadway Instructors - whose credits span 100 Broadway shows! ONE & TWO YEAR OFFERED IN SPRING & FALL. BFA IS ONLY OFFERED IN FALL!

The 2 Year Conservatory & BFA will begin its first year with the core fundamentals of musical theatre training - while the second year is advanced training in musical theatre as we introduce you to voice-over, on-camera, and the world of movie musicals.

As we are in NYC, we are able to offer extraordinary exposure to our students and potential of being placed in front of agents, managers, and casting directors - both in the classroom and on stage.

NYFA has a 4-Year Bachelor of Fine Arts One- and Two-Year Conservatory Program plus 1-Week and 4-Week Short-Term as well as 15-Week Online Workshop, a 4-Week Online Workshop and 5-Week Voiceover Workshop. We also offer 3 & 4-Week HS and 2-Week Kids (and Online Workshop). Currently these are only available at our NY campus & Online.

BFA Audition Requirements:

- Two (2) contrasting musical theatre songs; and
- One (1) contemporary monologue from a Published American Play; and
- At least one (1) dance video; and
- Wild Card (optional)

One & Two Year Audition Requirements:

- Two (2) contrasting musical theatre songs; and
- One (1) contemporary monologue from a Published American Play

Short Term IN PERSON Audition Requirements:

One musical theatre songs

*An Audition is Not Required for Online Workshops.

Performance opportunities each year include fully-produced musicals, final presentations, open-mic nights, and professional reading/s of new works by emerging composers. Students have the opportunity to audition for projects that fall within their program (not all opportunities are guaranteed).

Students also participate in filmed performance labs and staged final performances.

The 1st Year focuses primarily on the core fundamentals of musical theatre: singing, dancing, acting, audition technique, and building a book.

Dance classes include Jazz / Theatre Dance, Ballet, Tap, Modern, Ballroom & Hip Hop.

Singing classes include Private Voice Lessons, Song Interpretation (acting a song), Audition Technique, Pop Rock, Performance Lab, Improv, and will cover all genres of musical theatre (to name a few).

The 2nd Year & BFA Program continues to focus on musical theatre while incorporating **Acting for the Camera.** Students have the unique NYFA opportunity to participate in a filmed and produced movie musical project. Students will also complete a Voice Over Demo Reel and a Professionally-Recorded Digital Audition package. This recorded audition package consists of two contrasting songs that are professionally recorded, then sent to students as links to send to casting directors, agents, or add to their reel.

Biggest Difference in Conservatory and Degree (beyond the LAS classes): Two to Three Times the amount of performance opportunities and education in all areas. Deeper dive into acting for camera, the business of, new dance classes - commercial street jazz, ballroom & conditioning, movement & combat, dance audition tech, etc. Students will do 3 showcases for family and family (one of which they will put together as a class) and 1 for industry only - a total of 4. Thesis project is Self-written Solo Performance.

Industry Showcase Panel for 2nd Year & Degree Students Only

- The Showcase is for our graduating students to showcase their talent for casting directors, agents and managers.
- Made up of songs and scenes.
- · After they perform, the students will meet with every agent, casting director or agent that has watched their showcase. It works similar to "speed dating", where they will spend a few minutes with each of the industry professionals to get feedback - with the goal of potential representation and future auditions.

Students also participate in **filmed performance labs** and **staged showcases**.

This program takes place at our **Battery Park Location**, overlooking the Statue of Liberty and the Hudson River. As we are in NYC, we are able to offer extraordinary exposure to our students and potential of being placed in front of agents and casting directors - both in the classroom and on stage. Class Hours are typically 9am-6:30pm Monday to Friday OR Tuesday to Saturday, but will also include evening and weekend classes. This does not include time for rehearsals, auditions, prepping, shooting, shows, etc.
